Range Open for Winter

The range will remain open for the entire 2016-2017 Winter, weather permitting and barring any unforeseen complications. Members must park ONLY on Forbes and NOT on Watervliet F&G property, regardless of snow conditions. Snow plowing by Forbes will not be provided.

2017 Membership Dues and \$20 Late Fee

Smallbore League

The smallbore league is already underway, and it's not too late to join in the fun. Fifteen league matches alternate between home (Watervliet's indoor range) and away: Coxsackie, Iroquois (Rotterdam) and Pine Tree (Johnstown). The matches are held on Friday evenings and consist of 30 record shots and unlimited sighters at 50'; 10 each in prone, sitting/kneeling and offhand with a 40 minute time limit. New shooters are always welcome and lack of experience is no bar. The Watervliet indoor range is also open to any Forbes member for practice on Wednesdays starting at 8:00PM.
