For a given event, simply remove all of the rolled-up centers from the appropriate labeled section (of course... engineers were involved) and lay them out on the table. Trying to remove only a few and not the whole roll will result in damage. When done, just roll up what is left, put them back in the tube they came from, and replace the cap. One word of warning – please do not

push them on too far, about 1/4 inch is adequate. Otherwise they are tough to remove.

Nick brought over his ATV and tow behind trail mower to give the areas between the berms a final mow before the winter, with some help from Ed Simon. We all agree the grounds look great and we can get right to the business of shooting when Spring arrives.
