October 20th Work Party

Mark your calendars! Our fall work party has been set for Saturday, October 20, 2018:

• 8:00AM meet at the target shed area for coffee and donuts and planning (please use the 300-yard gate as Watervliet trap/skeet shooting will be in progress)

- Planned projects include:
 - o Remove, repair as needed, and put away target frames
 - o Repair two target carriers (chain sprockets spinning on axles)
 - Modify clamps on carrier axles to access and replace grease fittings (low end of pits).
 - Main shed roof repair. Our sealing efforts have not fixed the leaks. Roofing experience needed
 - Weed whacking around sheds, target boards and along left side between 200 and 300-yard berms. Application of 1-year growth inhibitor? Landscaping experience needed
 - Pits clean-out
 - o Inventory supplies and determine needs for 2019 season
 - Removal or trimming of any trees or branches interfering with range use. We must avoid the area between the 300 and 600-yard berms due to WFGPA skeet and trap shooting

Additional weed whackers, saws, screw guns, brooms and rakes will be helpful and put to good use. These work parties are fun and important ways of improving the looks and function of our club. Thanks, and we are looking forward to seeing anyone who can make it!
