SMALL BORE LEAGUE RESULTS

The Forbes' Small Bore Rifle Team did quite well this year with a second place finish of 9 wins and 6 losses in the Eastern New York Rifle League. The team average for 15 matches was 1441 and the team had to give away handicap points in 13 out of the 15 matches which means that the team outshot its opponents on scratch basis in most cases. Forbes lost 5 of the 13 matches where it gave away handicap points. Charlie Jewett led the team with an average of 293.83 and a high score of 296 with a high 96 offhand. Jeff Liddle ended up most improved with an extraordinary 12.85 increase in his average over last year. By way of records, in one match Forbes had to give away an incredible 126 points to an opponent, believed to be the most handicap points ever given to a team in the over 70 year history of the league.
